STATUTES ASSOCIATION - (change address)

ARTICLE 1: NAME

It consists in Cran-Gevrier, France, an association governed by the Act of 1 July 1901 under the title: "HELP ANNE FRANCOISE SISTER IN HIS MISSION TO INDIA"

ARTICLE 2: PURPOSE

This association aims to help Sister Anne Frances to continue its work and to attend among disadvantaged populations PRATHIPADU in INDIA.

ARTICLE 4: MEMBERSHIP

The association is governed by a board of nine members, including elected office including:
President - Vice President - Secretary and Treasurer

ARTICLE 5: RADIATION

Membership of the association is lost:

By resignation

By expulsion by the Board for non-payment of dues, or for serious reasons, the person concerned has been, in the latter case, previously invited by recommended to appear before the Committee to provide explanations.

ARTICLE 6: RESOURCES

The annual income of the association shall consist of:

Dues paid by its members,

Products of various parties or events.

ARTICLE 7: OFFICE

At the General Meeting, the Board will proceed with the formation of the Bureau and consists of:

-A President (e)

-A Vice-President (e)

-A secretary-

-A Treasurer (e)

The members are elected by secret ballot for a term of one year. Retiring members may be reappointed.

The Board shall meet whenever necessary, at the call of the President.

All functions of the Bureau are free. The Office may call upon qualified persons in an advisory capacity.

ARTICLE 8: GENERAL MEETING

The General Assembly consists of all members. It meets at least once a year upon convocation at least 15 days in advance. No quorum is required. Decisions are taken by majority vote. In case of a tie, the chairman has the casting vote. The General Assembly elects the members of the Board, shall appoint the members of honor, moral judgment on the report and the accounts for the year ended, fixed premium rates and in general, deliberates on the order day presented by the Board of Directors

ARTICLE 9: EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING

An Extraordinary General Meeting may be held either at the request of one third of the registered members, or at the request of the Bureau, to discuss one issue that caused the meeting.

ARTICLE 10: DISSOLUTION

The dissolution of the Association shall be made only at a General Meeting specially convened, and a majority of two thirds of registered members. If this majority is not obtained, a second meeting would be held 15 days later, and his decision would be valid regardless of the majority.

ARTICLE 11: SETTLEMENT

In case of dissolution, a committee of three or four members appointed will be responsible for the liquidation of the Association.

The net assets of the Association shall be vested in a body or other organization designated by the General Assembly.

Dissolution must be declared to the Prefecture of the Haute-Savoie Department.France
